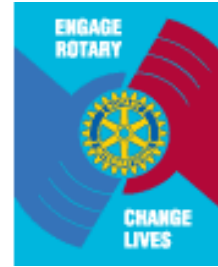


Meet Our Speaker: Ralph Bosek, COO

Mr. Bosek had a long, successful business and government career in the Tampa Bay area. Trained as an engineer, with B.S. and a M.S. from USF, he began his career in the food and beverage processing business in Florida. He gravitated to the professional services business and formed Bosek, Gibson, and Assoc., Inc. in 1986. This firm became the largest energy services business in the south-east, and was sold to TECO Energy in 1997. After working for TECO for several years subsequent to the sale of the consulting business, he became the Director of Community Services for the City of Temple Terrace and dealt with development, redevelopment, zoning, and other issues for the city. In 2008 Mr. Bosek became the Chief Operating Officer at MOSI, the seventh largest science center in the U.S. and is charged with developing and improving MOSI's multiple businesses.
