

Meet our Speaker: Dr. John Chapin

Dr. John Chapin is currently the Dean of Natural Sciences at St. Petersburg College. He has been in this position since July of 2012. As the Dean for Natural Sciences he is responsible for all facets of the institution's academic programs in the natural sciences. Included in the responsibilities are curricular, budgetary, and personnel management for the sciences on five of the institution's campuses. He is also responsible for the hiring, development, evaluation, and management of all natural science full-time faculty as well as the academic chairs on the five campuses of the institution that have natural science program offerings.

Prior to arriving at SPC he was the Vice President, of Workforce Development at Tallahassee Community College from 08/2007—06/2012. Where he was responsible for the entire non-degreed workforce training in the college. Workforce training includes the areas of Information Technology, Allied Health, Manufacturing, Business and Professional Development, Corporate Services and Construction/Trades.

Dr. Chapin has also served as Vice President of Instruction at Guilford Technical Community College, Dean, Division of Math, Science, and Allied Health at Polk State College. He was the Founding Associate Dean, Division of Sciences, Health, and Wellness at Lonestar College-Montgomery (formerly Montgomery College), and Founding Natural Sciences Faculty Member at Tarpon Springs Campus, St. Petersburg College.

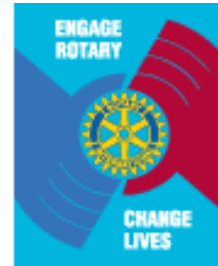
Dr. Chapin received his Bachelor of Science at Stetson University, his Master of Arts at USF, and his PhD at the University of Nebraska.
