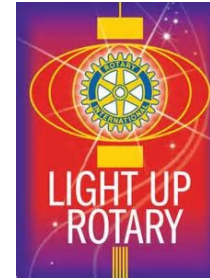


Meet Our Speaker: **Amber Saltzman**
