Prior to her current role, Kapes served as curator for Raymond James' Financial for 11 years, managing the private art collection of Tom and Mary James.



She is responsible for the selection and placement of art within the galleries. Kapes' goal is for the museum to be known for its stellar visitor experience and world class Western art.

As curator, her duties include management of the permanent collection of art and galleries and determining content and placement. She also develops and coordinates special exhibitions that will rotate. Over her career, Kapes has judged and juried national art competitions across the country – from Wisconsin to Wyoming.

She earned bachelor's degrees in art history and in studio art from the College of Charleston. When she isn't sharing art's historical narratives with museum visitors, she is training with her local running club. Kapes, a Georgia native, resides in St. Petersburg with her husband and 7-year-old twin boys.

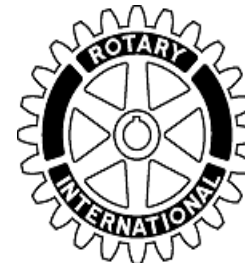
