Sailing has taken him to many great locations including South America, Europe, and Asia to name a few.

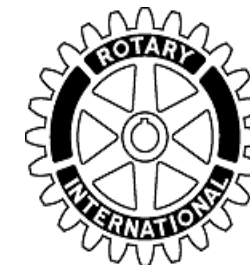
Mitch followed in his brother's footsteps and began sailing at the Clearwater Yacht Club in an 8-foot, singlehanded sailboat, the Optimist dinghy. In fact, Mitch's younger sister and older brother all competed on the same sailing team throughout their childhood. Mitch began teaching kids to sail shortly thereafter which only drove his passion for the sport even further. During his time at USF, Mitch was captain of the Sailing Team and captured the team's first National Championship.

Most recently, Mitch coached the Varsity Sailing Team at the College of Charleston in South Carolina. During his tenure, the sailing team was extremely successful winning seven national championships and named the 'best all-around sailing team' in the country four times. Thirty-nine student-athletes were named All-American or All-American Honorable Mentions during his 7 years as the Assistant Coach. Three of Mitch's sailors went on to compete in the Olympic games.
