Unfortunately, Marianne’s father did not share her vision. Wanting Marianne to build custom homes, as he was doing, he gave her an ultimatum to either change her major or she was on her own. She packed the trunk of her car and drove to Brandon Florida where her brother- in- law, an anesthesiologist, needed assistance in establishing his practice. Marianne quickly decided medical management would be her chosen field.

She first worked for HealthSouth Corp. as a member of their corporate acquisition team. Constant travel convinced Marianne to come back to Florida full time where she became chief operating officer for Florida Community Cancer and Imaging Centers. After 3 years of overseeing 18 outpatient centers, 30 physicians and a staff of 275, Marianne became the CEO for Oakhurst Medical Clinic and East Bay Medical Center who specialize in geriatric medicine. After 20 years in December 2017 Marianne successfully sold the practice.
